Kiso Sansen Park Water Area

The Kiso Sansen Park Water Area is located on the Nagara River 15 to 18 km upstream of the Nagara River Bridge. All watercraft operators must obey restrictions on watercraft navigation in this area.

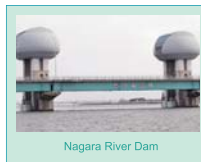
Nagara Conduit Intake

Restricted Areas of Nagara River Dam

All watercraft operators must obey restrictions on watercraft navigation (speed of 2 knots or lower) in the navigation zones within 100 m of the upstream and downstream sides of the restricted water area that stretches from 200 m upstream of the Nagara River Dam to 250 m downstream of the dam.



Nagara River Dam



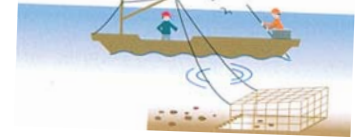
Low-Speed/Restricted Zones

- Within 50 m of the water's edge
- Within 50 m of steel towers
- 100 m upstream/downstream of bridges

Commercial Fishing on the Kiso Three Rivers

Freshwater Clam Fishing

Freshwater clam fishing is done frequently throughout the year. In all areas of the Kiso Three Rivers. Operations are particularly active during the morning hours, so exercise caution!



Net Fishing

Nets are strung across wide areas of the channels of the Kiso River and Nagara River upstream of the Tokai Bridge for net fishing throughout the year, so exercise caution!

Japanese Icefish Fishing and Seaweed Farming

From January 4 to April 30 each year, Japanese icefish fishing is done on the Kiso River, Nagara River and Ibu River downstream of National Highway 1.

In addition, seaweed farmers' fishing boats frequent the area from September to April, so exercise caution!

Navigate with care through areas prone to maritime accidents.
